and a will to engage with and learn more about different faith communities and their concerns and needs. We expect there will be more meetings, and we have communicated our concerns on issues such as immigration barriers and access to hospitals for our Buddhist chaplains.

The AGM was followed by a workshop on the Global Climate Crisis and how we respond to this peril. Christchurch-based Dharma teachers Julie Downard and Diana Robertson led this. Julie gave a talk about the strong scientific evidence for a climate emergency,



and Di led us through examining our inner responses to that. They then facilitated a discussion among all those present about compassionate action we could take individually and as a community, and how our practice and ethical commitments bring us to that.
